### **Voluntary Physiotherapist**

#### **The Job**

Reporting to the Team manager and Team Head Coach, the physiotherapist will be responsible for the following duties:

- Provide immediate physical therapy support during the competition, including dealing with sudden injuries, providing immediate first aid measures, such as dealing with sprains, strains, fractures, or dislocations.
- Help athletes recover after the competition, including cold compress, massage, joint traction, soft tissue release, etc., to promote rapid recovery of the body.

#### **Requirements:**

- A university degree in physiotherapy or a relevant discipline, preferably a master degree in sports physiotherapy or musculoskeletal physiotherapy;
- Preferable be registered by the Hong Kong Physiotherapy Board. For applicants who are not in Hong Kong but expected to be able to be registered by the Hong Kong Physiotherapist Board in 2026 would also be considered;
- Minimum of 2 years' physiotherapy or sports relevant working experience;
- Experience in managing sports injury;
